

Job Posting : Visitor Services

This is a full-time position at the George C. Reifel Migratory Bird Sanctuary in Delta. Duties consist of primarily visitor check-in procedures, and (secondarily) assisting other Sanctuary staff with various management duties (habitat, visitor use, and facilities). The applicant will be mainly working outside in variable weather and will need to work effectively in our small non-profit team.

There will be many opportunities for cross-training and team projects. The successful applicant will report directly to the Sanctuary Manager. This position is a fixed term contract and is intended to back-fill an existing position until another staff returns to work in the spring. The successful candidate will need to start immediately and commit to an employment term from September 1st 2024 to May 2025. There is potential for extended employment after May upon mutual consent.

We are seeking a friendly, outgoing team player with some local understanding of the Sanctuary and some experience working with the public and that can pick up skills and information readily. They will need to be able to communicate clearly and to answer general questions from visitors. Preference will be given to those familiar with rural life and some machinery, as well as some local plants and animals.

As part of the interview process, the aptitude to pick up skills may be tested. They must have their own transportation to the Sanctuary as there is no public transit to the Sanctuary. This position will be 5 days a week. Some work shifts will involve weekends.
